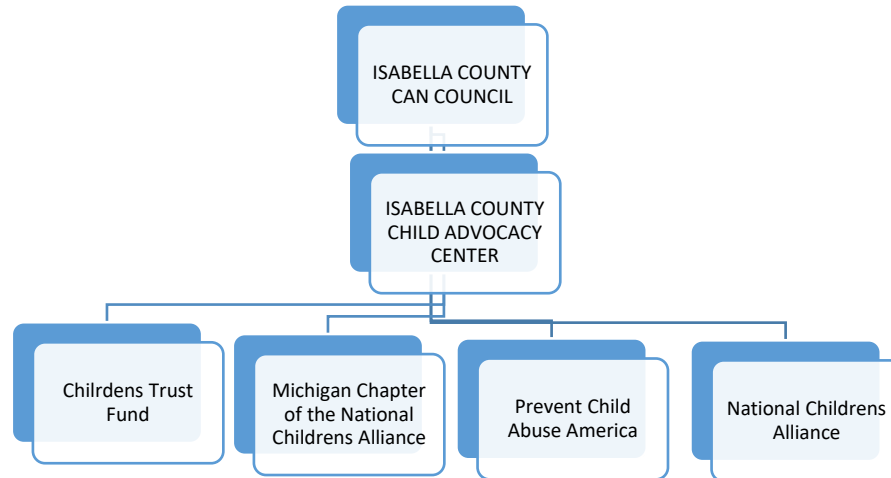


Organizational Chart
