Mt. Pleasant Public Schools Food Delivery: Lunch and breakfast is delivered to specified locations Monday-Friday. Breakfast and lunch will also be distributed at Mt Pleasant High School and Ganiard Elementary 11am-1pm, Monday-Friday **FREE** to anyone under 18 years old. Adult lunches can be purchased for \$2. Isabella County Soup Kitchen: A drive-thru, sack-style lunch will be offered on Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 11am-1pm each week until they are able to operate at capacity. All are welcome! (Closed Memorial Day)

Food Pantry at Strickler Center: Drive-thru Pantry dates: Wed. May 20<sup>th</sup> 2pm-6pm, Wed. May 27<sup>th</sup> 2pm-6pm, & Sat. May 30<sup>th</sup> 9am-11am. Please enter on High Street. No appointment needed.

## Supplies

Care Store at Strickler Center: Drive-thru distribution for emergency hygiene kits. Wed. May 20<sup>th</sup> 2pm-6pm, Wed. May 27<sup>th</sup> 2pm-6pm, & Sat. May 30<sup>th</sup> 9am-11am.

Life Choices of Central Michigan: There are currently no more scheduled drive-thru dates for diapers.

## Therapy

Call therapist for more specific needs. Most therapy services are done over phone at this time.
